Award Criteria

South Surrey Garden Club member in good standing who has:

- Given service to the Club for not less than five years
- Made significant service contributions to the Club in any number of volunteer positions and/ or has provided leadership to the Club contributing consistently to the well-being of fellow members and to the Club
- Not received the award previously
